The data collection by SRS Senior Resource Coordinator, Melanie Bremaud, began in September 2019.

If the 4 months of 2019 reflect the pre-COVID demand, the annualized number would be $44 \times 3 = 132$ trips per annum. During 2020 and the 3 following years, the number of requests for transportation and the number of volunteer drivers have not reached the pre-COVID levels of 2019. The most common reason for the request for transportation is for medical appointments. The trips originate across the geographic area. The destination varies depending on need. Our volunteer drivers are not able to accommodate seniors with mobility concerns requiring wheelchairs.
